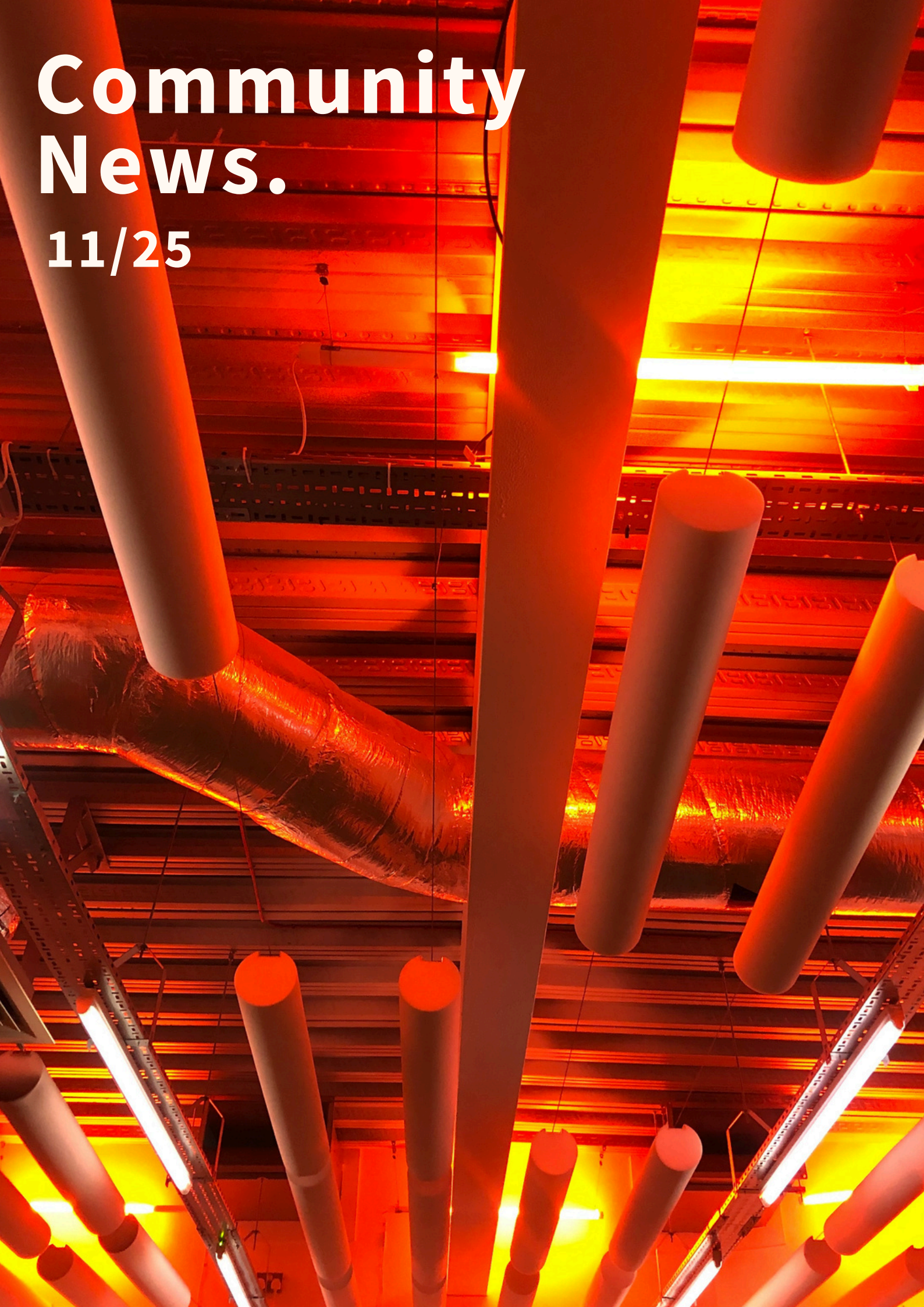

# LINK LEARNING TAKE NEW OFFICE SPACE

Link Learning support children to learn, grow and express themselves through music, art and performance. Working with the very best teachers and creatives, Founder Sam Richardson and his team, partner with schools, community groups, childcare providers and health and wellbeing organisations. Together, they bring bespoke creative courses and opportunities to young people.

Incorporating in 2018, over the last seven years Link Learning has expanded its services out of Sheffield and is now operating nationally. Sam moved from his early base in Electric Works' co-working club, into their first private office in March 2022. The recent move to their second-floor-office here at Electric Works was a business-critical step in their ambitious five-year growth plan. Much more spacious than their previous room, their new office-come-music-studio will accommodate the employee team of five and regular visitors from their vast network of creative practitioners and partners.

The team also have a second satellite office in Broomhall which is home to their Community Interest Company spin-out and a range of community projects delivered in the area. Of the recent office space move - Sam said: *"We love being located here at Electric Works and I've had my eye on this particular office for a while. When it became available, we jumped at it. We now have a wall of windows, loads of natural light, space to be creative and to collaborate, and importantly, room to scale our business and invest in our growth."*

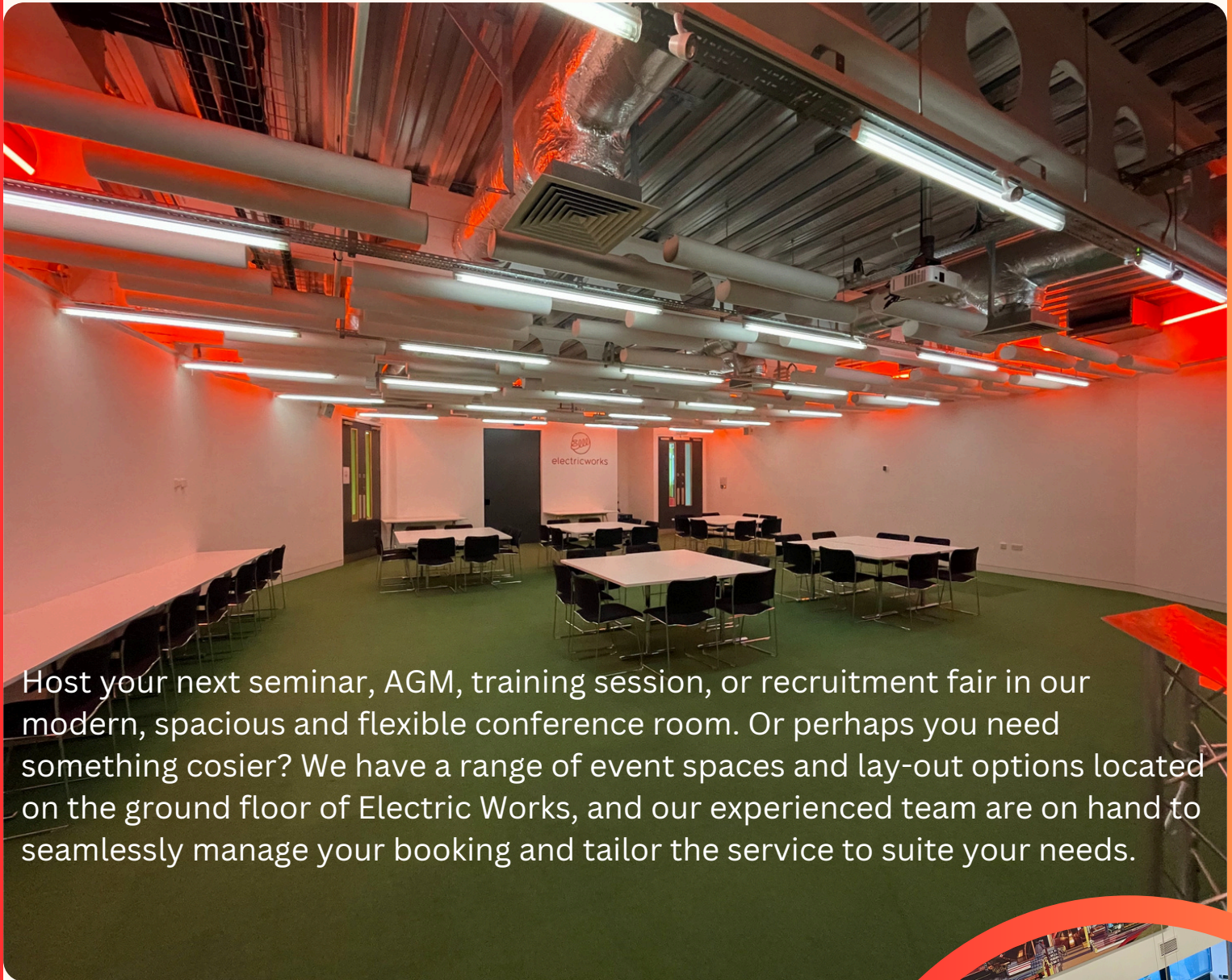
