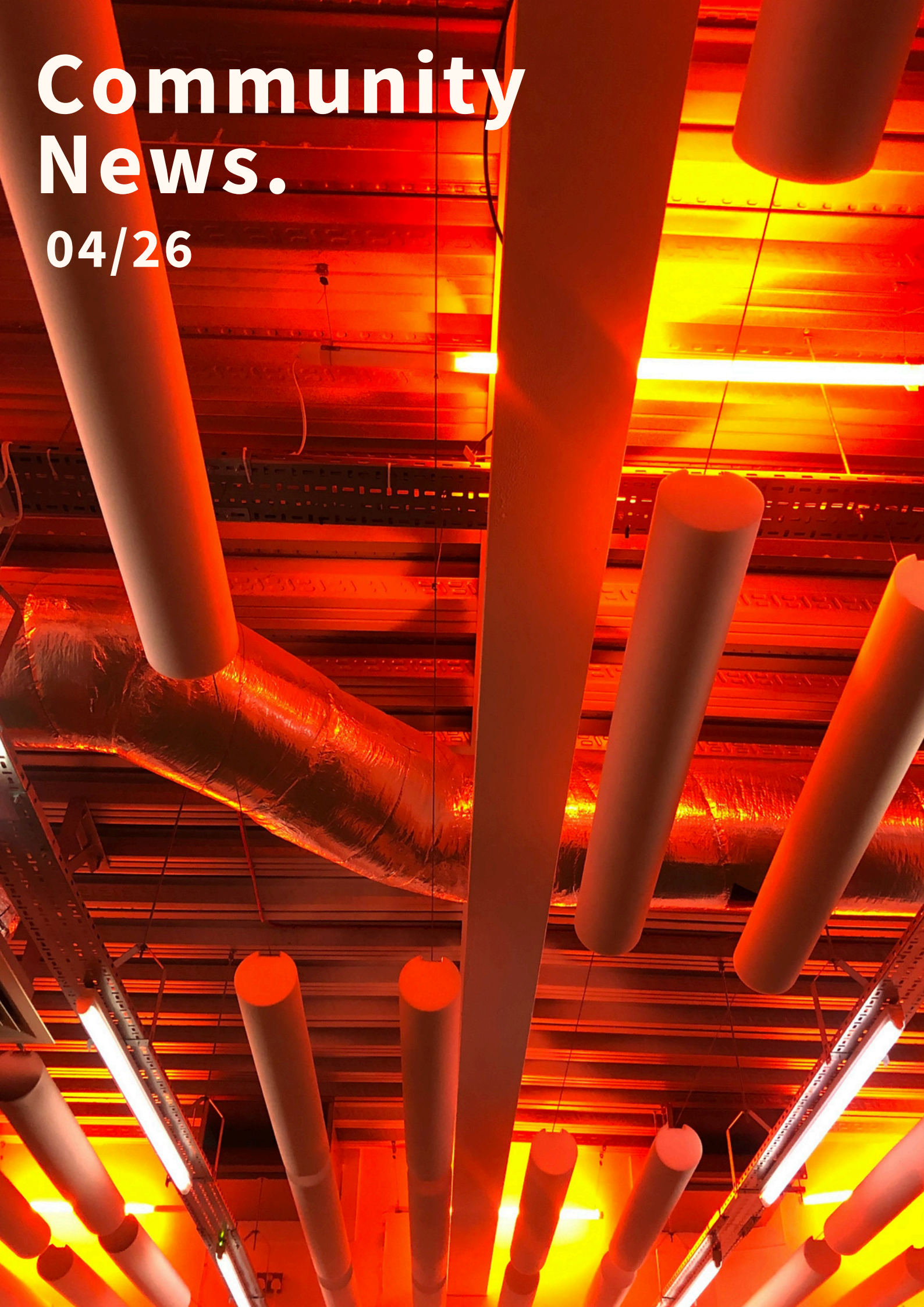

Electric Works welcomes [KnowBe4](#) to the workspace community. The 60-strong KnowBe4 Sheffield team recently took two offices at Electric Works, here on the Sheffield Digital Campus.

KnowBe4 is a cybersecurity business with its headquarters in North America. Outside of the States, this multinational company operates from 14 offices worldwide and four of these are in England; based in London, Leeds, Cheltenham and Sheffield.

KnowBe4 works with more than 70,000 organisations globally, building security culture and helping teams manage both human and agent risk. KnowBe4's human risk management platform helps organisations recognise and respond to security risks.

We caught up with International Facilities Manager, Neil Brownsword, to learn more about his experience moving into Electric Works and what appealed about this workspace: “The move-in has been incredibly smooth. The front-of-house team here at Electric Works has excelled itself, and it is a huge bonus for us to have a friendly and helpful reception team to welcome our staff and our visitors into the building each day.”

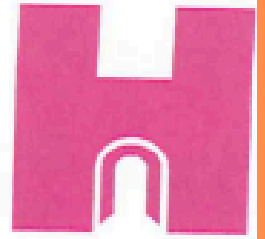
