MERCIA & FW CAPITAL SHORTLISTED FOR SHEFFIELD BUSINESS AWARDS

Play Padel opened their doors in Abbeydale just over a year ago. Since then, over 7,000 people have played Padel with them, and they've maintained near-100% court occupancy every single month.

The Collaboration Excellence Award celebrates successful partnerships between two or more organisations that have resulted in a positive impact on the local region. This award acknowledges the importance of collaboration in achieving common goals, creating a better community for all, and evidencing excellence in team collaboration while achieving the desired outcome.

SHEFFIELD IN TOP FIVE OF UK'S MOST RELAXING CITY BREAK DESTINATIONS

Sheffield's visitor economy attracted over 18 million visitors on the latest count.

A recent article in unLTD magazine highlighted a 7.3% increase compared to the previous year – generating more than £2 billion for Sheffield's economy and supporting over 16,000 full-time equivalent jobs.

Driven by a world-class calendar of cultural events like Tramlines and DocFest, a thriving independent food scene, and its reputation as the UK's greenest city on the doorstep of the Peak District, Sheffield has firmly established itself as a premier destination for business and leisure alike.

The positive impact of this growth in tourism and regional visibility has a knock on affect for our workspace and our businesses based here.

Located just two minutes from Sheffield Station, Electric Works is one of the first buildings people see as they arrive in Sheffield. This is useful, not just for our occupiers' visiting clients, but for the business tourists that arrive in the city for the growing number of events and conferences we are hosting.

The tenth edition of Sheffield's Castlegate Festival is set to take place 12 - 20 September.

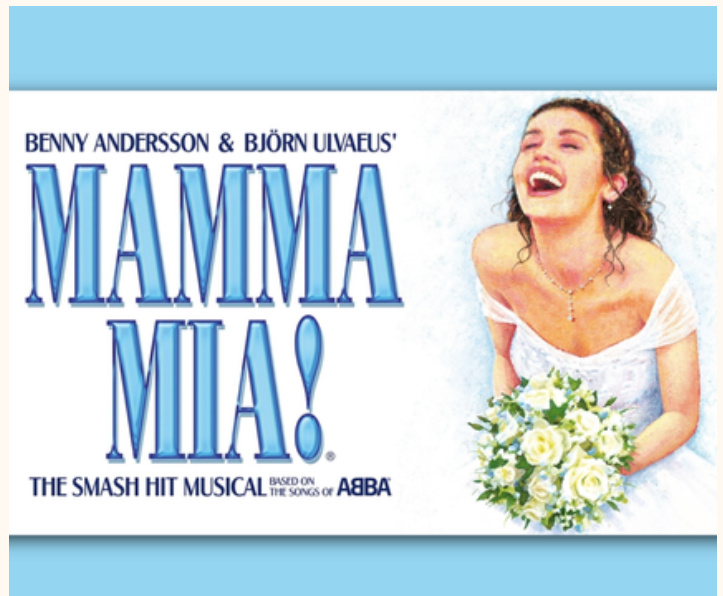
The festival is a celebration of heritage as well as the rich arts, music and market scene in Castlegate, Sheffield's oldest quarter.
